Embrace Winter and Count Birds for Science



Do you love birds? Do you have a bird feeder outside your home or office? Then you can be a citizen scientist

and take part in Project FeederWatch! <u>Project FeederWatch</u> surveys the birds that visit feeders across the country from November through early April so scientists can track trends in bird populations.

By entering your data, you are helping scientists learn about long-term trends in bird distribution and abundance, the kinds of foods and environmental factors that attract birds, and how disease is spread among birds that visit feeders.
