CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

There is still time to apply for the NC State **Extension Master Gardener Certification** Program! This program is an extensive gardening course that teaches topics such as botany, lawns, soils, insects, diseases, ornamentals, small fruits, weed identification and management, organic culture, composting, wildlife, propagation, pesticides, and landscape design. Program attendees have often said that the training is equivalent to a college course in horticulture. We have an award-winning manual to accompany this training; it can be purchased as a hard copy or an electronic pdf. The training cost is dependent on your manual choice, ranging from \$80 (without the manual) to \$125 (with the manual). Once the training is completed, you are encouraged to stay with the local program and offer volunteer hours to our community and local residents of the great Surry County. The program is designed to each you, and then you compliment the Extension horticulture office by sharing your newly

acquired knowledge at community events, field days, and/or educational exhibits; teaching or demonstrating gardening to senior citizens, youth, or special needs groups. Gardening is a very practical, therapeutic, and relaxing activity that can benefit everyone. If

you have an interest or passion for gardening and a desire to help your fellow neighbor, then this may be just the program for you.



We are offering the training in the upcoming year, weekly on Tuesday afternoons, from 1:00 pm until 4:30 pm, at N.C. Cooperative Extension, Surry County Center. The classes will begin February 5 and finish April 30. We have an outstanding lineup of speakers, each excelling in the topic they will be presenting. An orientation meeting has been scheduled for January 22 at 10:00 am for those interested. It will also be a time to meet with our current NC State Extension Master Gardener Volunteers and NC State Extension Master GardenerSM program coordinator, Ms. Charlotte Glen. Program applications can be completed and submitted at this time as well.
