Pilot Mountain Nature Adventure

It's time to go on a nature adventure at Pilot Mountain State Park! We will meet at the Visitor's Center where we will be exploring the park with a Park Ranger. They will help us learn about the geology of the mountain and the park, as we explore rocks and minerals found there. We'll look at the recovery of the park since the recent wildfire, and find out how wildfires are actually beneficial. We will be going on a hike to explore the vegetation and animals that are native to the park, and doing a scavenger hunt to see what we can spot along the way! All participants should wear closed-toe shoes, bring a packed lunch, and a filled water bottle. You may also want to apply sunscreen or bug spray, since we will be outdoors quite a bit.





Life Skills Rodeo

Everyone needs to learn basic life skills! Come have fun in this week-long camp as we learn from several members of our community through engaging hand-on lessons. On Monday, we will have faculty from Surry Community College helping us prepare for our education with session on dual enrollment, scholarships, and job internships. On Tuesday, we will have State Employees' Credit Union teaching us about Personal Finance. We will learn about making a budget, checking and savings accounts, types of loans, interest rates, credit cards, and building and maintaining credit. Think a real-world game of Life! On Wednesday, we will be exploring Nutrition and Fitness. We will be learning about how to make healthier food and drink choices, ways to help us drink our recommended daily water intake, sampling some healthy snacks, and creating a menu. On Thursday, we will be learning laundry and basic sewing skills. We will look at clothing labels to determine how they should be washed, sorting laundry, operating a washing machine and dryer, and hanging and folding clothes neatly. We will also learn some basic sewing skills and how to mend clothing. On Friday, we will take everything that we learned during the week from budgeting, planning a menu, and making healthy food and drink choices. We will be cooking, learning to properly set a table, making an attractive food display, and table etiquette. After this week, you should be ready to practice "adulting!"

Registration

We will only be taking registrations in-person this year. A completed registration form & fees must be submitted at the time of registration. Registration for each event will stay open until two weeks prior to the event, or until all spots are filled. We encourage you to sign up as early as possible!

Fees

There is a one-time \$20 registration fee per child. This covers a t-shirt for each camper and a snack each day. Some camps may have additional fees, to cover costs of materials. Checks are preferred or cash will be accepted. Please bring exact change, as our office does not keep cash on hand. Checks should be made to "Surry County 4-H." Debit and credit cards are not accepted. Clover Cash that has been earned through fundraisers may be used to pay for summer camps, however the 4-H Agent must be notified that you are using Clover Cash to pay at the time of registration. Contact Amanda Gann if you need to know your Clover Cash balance.

Location

Activities will be held at the Surry County Cooperative Extension Office (915 E. Atkins Street, Dobson), unless otherwise noted. A parent/guardian must accompany the child each day, sign the participant in, and indicate who will be picking them up. A parent/guardian must also come sign each participant out, in order for them to leave. For the safety of your child, as well as consideration of instructors and Extension staff, please do not bring your child more than 10 minutes early to an event.

4-H Enrollment

4-H Online enrollment is required in the state of North Carolina. Please make sure to fill out the full 4-H Online Account and make a profile for each child you are enrolling prior to registering them for Summer Fun programs.
